### Masculine nouns

#### ending in -o

- el cuaderno | the notebook
- el diario | the diary
- el diccionario | the dictionary
- el número | the number
- el video | the video

#### ending in -ma

- el problema | the problem
- el programa | the program

#### ending in -s

- el autobús | the bus
- el país | the country

### Feminine nouns

#### ending in -a

- la cosa | the thing
- la escuela | the school
- la computadora | the computer
- la maleta | the suitcase
- la palabra | the word

#### ending in -ción

- la lección | the lesson
- la conversación | the conversation

#### ending in -dad

- la nacionalidad | the nationality
- la comunidad | the community

- To form the plural, add S to nouns that end in a vowel.
- Nouns that end in a consonant add -es.
- Nouns that end in -z change the z to a c. Then add -es.
- In general, when a singular noun has an accent mark on the last syllable, the accent is dropped from the plural form.
